

I Nathaniel Low junior Commissioner duly appointed & sworn under the Statute of an Act made in the 2^d & 3^d years of the Reign of King William the 4th intituled "An Act to Amend & settle several Acts passed respectively in the 5th 6th 7th & 8th years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the 3^d providing for the establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland & to make such Compositions permanent to ascertain & fix a true & just Composition within the Parish of St. John's within the County of Meath do hereby Certify that the true & just Amount of Compositions for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Forty Pounds

by the year which sum of Forty Pounds is due & payable to the Rev. Richard Butler as a Composition for the Tithes Annually by him as Vicar of the Rectorial Tithes of said Parish.

And I do further Certify that the Average Price of Cattle being the Cows principally grazed in such County for the Period of seven years ending the said day of November 1830 is Thirteen Shillings & three pence three farthings & a half
