Commissioners duly appointed and sworn, under, and by virtue of an
Act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the
fourth, intituled, "An Act to provide for the establishing of
"compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time,"
to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes,
arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Sta-
halmack in the County of Meath: do hereby Certify-
that the true and just amount of all Tithes whatever within the
said Parish of Stahalmack is One hundred and ten Pounds
Sterling by the year, which sum of One hundred and ten Pounds
is due and payable to the Rev^d Brabaron William Disney,
as a composition for all Tithes claimable by him as Rector of
said Parish.

And we do further certify that the Average price of Oats
being the corn principally grown in such County for the
period of seven years, ending the first day of November
1821, is fifteen Shillings two pence half penny by the Barrell
