

We Robert James and William Monkittick (commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of King George the fourth (intituled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time) To ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all the Tithes arising, growing, Yielded or payable within the parish of Stickillen and County South. Do hereby Certify that the just and true amount of Composition for all the Tithes whatsoever within the said parish of Stickillen is One Hundred and sixteen pounds fourteen Shillings and six pence by the Year; of which sum sixteen pounds fourteen Shillings and six pence is due and payable by the Year to the Revd Arthur Ellis as Vicar of said parish and the remaining sum of One Hundred pounds by the Year is due and payable to the Rt. Honble Lord Bish. Ferrar, as Lay Impropriator of the Great Tithes of said parish of Stickillen —

And we do further Certify that the average price of wheat being the grain principally grown in such County for the period of seven Years ending on the 1st Day of November 1821 to be £1. 18. 8¹/₂ late currency equal to £1. 15. 8 present Currency per Barrel. —
