

We Robert Innes and William Munkittrick Commissioners
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth
year of the reign of King George the 4th (intituled an act to provide
for the composition of Tithes in Ireland for a limited time) do
ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes
arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of
Stickillen and County of Louth. Do hereby Certify that
the true and just amount of ~~all~~ Composition for all Tithes
whatever within the Said Parish is One Hundred and Sixteen
pounds fourteen Shillings and Six pence by the Year.

Of which Sum Sixteen pounds fourteen Shillings and Six
pence by the Year is due and payable to the Rev.
Arthur Ellis as Vicar of Said Parish and the remaining
Sum of One Hundred pounds by the Year is due and
payable to the R^t. Honble Lord Visct. Ferrard as lay
impropriator of the great Tithes of Said Parish of Stickillen.

And we do further Certify that the average price of
Wheat being the Grain principally grown in Such County for
the period of Seven Years ending on the first day of November
1821 is £1. 18. 8² Late Currency or £1. 15. 8 present Currency
per Barrel. —
