One hundred and Sixty Pounds by the year payable at the  
perpetual rate thereof -

And We do further Certify that the  
average price of Wheat being the Corn principally  
grown in such County for the period of seven  
years ending at the first day of November 1824 is  
L1 - 18 - 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Per Bushel
