for the establishing of a Composition for Tithes in  
Ireland for a limited time", to ascertain & fix a  
true & just composition for all tithes arising, grow-  
-ing, or payable within the parish of Stone-hall,  
in the County of Westmeath, do hereby certify  
that the true & just amount of Composition for  
all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is  
Ninety pounds British, by the year, payable  
to the Earl of Bective as the Lay Impropriator.

And we further certify, that the average price  
of oats, being the Corn principally grown in  
said County, for the period of seven years  
ending the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 1821 is Fifteen Shil-  
-lings & two pence farthing per Barrel.
