Shumcayby in the County of Sulbhenny do hereby Certify  
that the true and Just amount of Compositions for  
all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Thirty  
five pounds Eighteen Shillings and five pence half penny  
per annum which sum is due and payable to the  
Rev<sup>d</sup> Tho<sup>s</sup> Hemmings as Rector & Vicar of said parish  
and we do further Certify that the said sum of  
Thirty five pounds Eighteen Shillings and five pence  
half penny is a Just and fair composition for said Tithes  
as agreed upon at a meeting duly assem<sup>d</sup> for the full  
and term of Twenty One years from the first  
day of November One Thousand Eight Hundred and  
Twenty four without Variation whatsoever
