

I John Kidd Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under
 and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of his late Majesty
 King William the fourth, entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in
 the fourth, fifth and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of His Majesty
 King George the fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in
 Ireland, and to make such compositions permanent; and by virtue of another
 Act passed in the second and third years of Her Majesty Queen Victoria entitled
 an Act to abolish compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to substitute Rent
 Charges in lieu thereof - to ascertain and set a true and just composition for all
 Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Stancarty,
 alias Stancarty and County of Kilkenny. do hereby certify that the true and
 just amount of composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish
 is one hundred and six pounds five shillings and four pence halfpenny Sterling,
 by the year, of which sum of one hundred and six pounds five shillings and
 four pence halfpenny, two third parts (that is to say the sum of seventy pounds,
 sixteen shillings and eleven pence) are due and payable to the Vicars Choral
 and Choirmen of Christ's Church and Saint Patrick's Dublin, as a composition
 for the Rectorial Tithes claimable by them, one third part (that is to say the sum
 of thirty five pounds eight shillings and five pence halfpenny is due and payable
 to the Vicar of the said Parish for the time being,
