

I John Palmer Howard having being duly
Appointed and Sworn Commissioner under and by virtue
of an Act made in the 22nd and 3rd Years of the Reign of King
William the 4th Chapter 119. Intituled an Act to amend three
Acts passed respectively in the 4th 5th 7th and 8th Years of the
Reign of His late Majesty King George the 4th providing
for the Establishing of Composition of Tithes in Ireland
and to make such Compositions permanent, 16th August 1832
to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all
Tithes arising, yielding, growing or payable within the
Parish of Ardaboe in the County of Carlow - - Do
hereby Certify that the true and just Amount of Composi-
tion for all Tithes whatever within said Parish is One
Hundred and fifteen Pounds, ten Shillings and two pence
by the Year - And that that Sum is due and payable
to the Reverend John Whitty as a Composition for all
Tithes claimed by him as Incumbent of the Parish
And I do further Certify the average
price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in
said County for the period of the Seven Years ending
the 1st November 1830, is One Pound, twelve Shillings
and 1/2 pence British per Barrel -
