bearing date in the month of April 1825 and
in pursuance of the Statutes in such case made
and provided and by which Certificate the Gross
amount of Composition for all tithes whatever in
said Parish was ascertained to be the annual
sum of £ 300 of the then currency equivalent
to the sum of £ 276. 18. 5½ of the present currency
of which sum of £ 300 of the then currency
£ 200 equivalent to £ 184. 12. 3¾ of the
present currency being two third parts thereof
was certified to be due and payable to William
Lewis Esquire thereon mentioned as a composition
for the Dute claimable by him as the owner of
the Rectorial Dute each and every year and
£ 100 equivalent to £ 92. 6. 1¾ of the present
Currency the remaining one third part thereof
was certified to be due and payable to the Revd.
Thomas Harper the Vicar of said Parish each
and every year And Whereas the said Robert
Ashworth Godolphin Cosby Thomas Kimmis and
Henry William Baron Congleton made application
in writing to the Justices of the Peace at the
Quarter Sessions above mentioned to have the
average price of oats per barrel (Gross the
Grain in said Certificate mentioned) for the

preceding seven years in pursuance of the
Statute in that behalf enquired of and
ascertained in order that the said Composition
for Dutes and the Dute Rent charge in the
thereof might be varied and diminished according
to such average price taken from the Dublin
Gazette for such period as compared with the
average price of 15½ per barrel of the then
Currency equivalent to the sum of 14/- of
the present currency per barrel as set forth in
said Certificate And Whereas the said applicants
having appeared in person and by their
agent before the said Justices at such
Quarter Sessions and the said Justices of
application and said Certificate and the
Dute of the applicants having been proved
NOW the said Justices do ascertain
from the said Dublin Gazette that the
average price of oats for the said period
of seven years immediately preceding the
date hereof is 11½ for each barrel of
fourteen stone of oats as aforesaid And
the said Justices do accordingly order and
~~adjudge~~ that the amount of said Composition
in said Parish for the said Inappropriate
Dutes and the Rent charge payable in
the thereof shall be diminished in proportion
