

We the Rev^d Thomas Kemmis and Edward Lewis
commissioners duly appointed and sworn under
by virtue of an act made in the 4th year of the
reign of King George the fourth, intituled an act
to provide for the Establishment of compositions for
Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and
fix a true composition for all tithes arising, growing,
yielded or payable within the parish of Straboe
in the Queen's County, do hereby certify, that the true
and just amount of composition for all tithes whatso-
ever within the said parish is Three hundred pounds
Sterling by the year: of which sum of Three hundred
pounds, Two thirds are due and payable to William
Lewis Esq^r of the City of Dublin as a composition for
the Tithe claimable by him as the ~~part of said~~
~~the~~ owner of the Rectorial Tithe, and one third
part is due and payable to the Rev^d Thomas Har-
pur vicar of the said parish.

And we do further certify, that the average price
of Oats, being the Corn principally grown in
said County for the period of seven years
