years of the Reign of King William the fourth entitled an act
to amend the ~~to~~ passed respectively in the fourth fifth
and in the seventh and eight years of the Reign of his late
Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing
of Composition for tithes in Ireland, and to make such
Composition permanent, ascertain and fix a true and just
Composition for all tithes arising growing yielding or payable
within the Parish of Stradblacey in the County of Kerry
do hereby certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all tithes whatsoever within the Parish is
one Hundred and eighty five pounds by the Year which sum
is due and payable to the Revd Edwin Thomas as a
Composition for all tithes claimable by him as Rector of
the said Parish, -

And I do further certify that the
average price of wheat being the Corn principally grown
in such Parish for the period of seven years ending
first November 1830, is one pound Twelve shillings
and ten pence halfpenny of a barrel of Twenty Stone -
Dated 4 June 14th 1834
