De Burgh & one or more of the Church Wardens of the Parish of Castle Connell & Killinagariff & Michael Emory & his assistants to levy the sum of fifty seven pounds nineteen shillings & one penny, being at the rate three pence halfpenny per acre on the above named Parishes pursuant to act of Parliament for the purpose ordered at Vestry, & for so doing this shall be their sufficient authority given under our hands & seals this 12 day of Aug^r 1822

We the Undersigned Justices of the Peace for S^d Counties, do authorize & empower Michael Emory & his assistants to collect and receive the sum of £57-19-1 being at the rate of 3^d of an acre and every acre liable to pay the Parish cess, and if any of the Landholders refuse or neglect to pay you are to levy the same by distress & sale of their Goods and Chattels and any surplus remaining after deducting the charge of 2^d for each distress, so taken pursuant to act of Parliament made and provided in that behalf -

We the Undersigned do certify that the above applotment is just and correct as a Vestry legally summoned and held in the Parish Church of Castle Connell on the eighth day of April 1822 for the Union of Castle Connell and Killinagariff Pursuant to notice given. It was then and there agreed on by the Ministers, Church Wardens, and Protestant Parishioners that the sum of 3^d of an acre be raised upon each and every acre in the said United Parishes for the purpose of paying the Clerk Salary and providing the Communion Elements and other Expence Dated this 9 day of Aug^r 1822
