

payment of Three pounds or upwards
in respect of Tithe composition and
Tithe rent-charge by the certificate of
Arthur Moore Mosse a commissioner bearing
date the twenty-fourth day of September
one thousand eight hundred and thirty
three and in pursuance of the statutes
in such case made and provided and
by which certificate the gross amount of
composition of all tithes whatever in
said Parish was ascertained to be
the annual sum of £207:13:10 of which
sum £69:4:7 $\frac{1}{4}$ was certified to be
due and payable to the Revd Hunt
Johnson (therein mentioned) as a composition
of all Tithes claimed by him as Vicar
of said Parish of Stradbally and that
the sum of £138:9:7 $\frac{1}{2}$ was payable
to the Representatives of the late John
Bailey who was Lessee of Trinity College
as Rector of said Parish and it was
thereby further certified that the
average price of wheat being the
corn principally grown in said County
for the period of seven years ending
the 1st day of November 1830 was one
pound twelve shillings and a halfpenny

per barrell

And Whereas the said Robert
Godolphin Cosby, William Young and
Lionel George Henry Seymour Earl of
Portarlington made application in writing
to the Justices of the Peace at the Quarter
Sessions above mentioned to have
the average price of wheat per barrell
(being the grain in said certificate
mentioned) for the preceding seven
years in pursuance of the statutes
in that behalf enquired of & ascertained
in order that said composition for
tithes & the tithe rent-charge payable
in lieu thereof might be varied and
diminished according to such average
price taken from the Dublin Gazette
for such period as compared with the
average price of one pound twelve shillings
and a halfpenny set forth in said certificate
And Whereas the said applicants having
appeared in person and by their agent
before the said Justices at such Quarter
Sessions and the said notices of application
and said certificate and the right of said
applicants to have said composition
for tithes and tithe rent-charge in lieu
