satisfaction Now the said Justices
do ascertain from the said Dublin
Gazette that the average price of wheat
for seven years immediately preceding
the date hereof is seventeen shillings and
five pence three farthings for each barrell
of twenty stone of wheat as aforesaid and
the said Justices do accordingly order and
adjudge that the amount of said composition
in said parish for the said Improprate
Tithes and the Rent charge payable in
lieu thereof shall be diminished in such
and the same ratio & proportion as the
aforesaid price of £11:12:0½ per barrell
as stated in said certificate of corn bears
to the average price of seventeen shillings
and five pence three farthings And the
said Justices do further order that the
applotment of such composition shall be
amended & diminished accordingly and that
the said diminution shall take effect from
the first day of November 1896
