

be further varied by directing a reapportionment of the said sum of twenty two pounds three shillings and eleven pence farthing upon the residue of the lands in the said Parish not tithed free Whereupon it was ordered that upon the Petitioner depositing Ten pounds with the Registrar of this Court within one week this matter should be set down to be reheard touching the matters in the petition referred to. That the said deposit was accordingly made. And the said Petition coming on this day to be heard before His Lordship in the presence of Counsel learned for the Petitioner The Duke of Devonshire no one appearing for any other party. Upon hearing the said petition and order for rehearing dated the seventh day of May one thousand eight hundred and fifty five Notice of motion bearing date the sixteenth day of May one thousand eight hundred and fifty five Order bearing date the twenty eighth day of July one thousand eight hundred and thirty three Certificate of Tithe Composition bearing date the eighth day of August one thousand eight hundred and thirty three Order made by the Privy Council bearing date the twenty sixth day of October one thousand eight hundred

and thirty three. Apportionment of said Composition bearing date the thirtieth day of December one thousand eight hundred and thirty three The affidavit of Vice Revenue William Johnson Ardagh filed the thirtieth day of April one thousand eight hundred and fifty five as also the affidavit of Thomas Edward Kelly Esquire filed the third day of May one thousand eight hundred and fifty five read, and what was alleged by the said Counsel His Lordship doth order that the order made in this matter bearing date the twenty eighth day of July one thousand eight hundred and fifty three be varied so far as the same directs that the Certificate of Tithe Composition should be amended by omitting such direction and It is further ordered that the said order be further amended by ~~declaring~~ declaring that the said order shall be without prejudice to the right of the Respondent The Duke of Devonshire to have a reapportionment of the sum of twenty nine pounds eleven shillings and eleven pence tithe composition (which has been reduced by the operation of the said act of Parliament into a rent charge of twenty two pounds three shillings and eleven pence farthing per annum) Upon the lands
