

I Thomas Edward Keily a Commissioner duly appointed and sworn
under and by virtue of an act passed in the second and third -
years of the reign of his present Majesty King William the Fourth
intituled "An act to amend three acts passed respectively in the
Fourth, Fifth and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his
late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the establishing
of compositions for tithes & tithes and to make such composition
permanant." So ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all
tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of
Stradbally in the Diocese of Lismore and County of Waterford. So hereby
certify that the true and just amount of composition for all tithes
whatsoever within the said Parish is Eight Hundred and Eighty five pounds
thirteen shillings ^{shillings} by the year of which the sum of Five Hundred and
ninety pounds eight shillings and eight pence being the two third parts
of said sum of Eight Hundred and Eighty five pounds thirteen shillings
is due and payable to His Grace the most Noble William Spencer
Duke of Devonshire as a composition for two thirds of the tithes of
said Parish claimable by him as Lay Impropriator thereof - And the sum
of Two Hundred and ninety five pounds four shillings and four pence
being the one third part of said sum of Eight Hundred and Eighty five pounds
thirteen shillings is due and payable to the Reverend Doctor John
Devereux as a composition for the remaining one third of the tithes
of said Parish claimable by him as Vicar thereof - And I do further
certify that the average price of oats being the corn principally
grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the
first of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty is Twelve
shillings and eleven pence halfpenny per Barrel - Given under my hand
this eighth day of August one thousand eight hundred and thirty
