

I, John Lynch, Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under  
and by virtue of an Act passed in the second & third years of the  
Reign of King William the Fourth entitled an Act to amend three  
Acts passed respectively in the Fourth Fifth, Seventh and Eighth years  
of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing  
for the establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland, & to make  
such Composition permanent, to ascertain and fix the true and  
just amount of Composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded  
or payable in the Parish or Prebend of Subulter in the Diocese  
of Cloyne and County of Cork, do hereby Certify that the true and  
just amount of Composition for all tithes whatever in said Parish  
or Prebend is Sixtythree pounds six Shillings Stg. every year  
which sum is due and payable to the Rev. Nicholas Nixon  
as a Composition for the tithes claimable by him as Rector of the  
said Parish or Prebend, And I do further Certify that  
the Average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in  
said County for the period of seven years ending on the first  
day of November 1830, is one pound twelve Shillings and  
ten pence per Barrel, Dated this 23<sup>d</sup> day of October 1833.
