We Jonathan David Clarke of the City of Dublin and Charles Farran of Tettrim Castle in the County of Dublin Esquires Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth entitled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Kinsaley in the County of Dublin, do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two Hundred and Twenty four Pounds and 16. 11<sup>q</sup>. by the year of which sum of Two Hundred and Twenty four Pounds and 16. 11<sup>q</sup>. Two third Parts are due & payable to the Rev. Stewart Leger Trench as a Composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of the said Parish and one third Part is due and payable to him
