

J. Arthur Batterley Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of the Reign of His present Majesty King William the fourth entitled "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such compositions permanent" - to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within those parts of the Parish of Swords in the Diocese of Dublin known as the Lands of Rathbeal Skidowe and Killeegh, do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within those parts of the parish of Swords above named is One hundred and sixty eight pounds three shillings and five pence halfpenny Sterling by the year; which is due and payable to the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Saint Patrick Dublin in the following proportions, that is to say. the sum of Sixty nine pounds seven shillings and seven pence halfpenny from off the Lands of Rathbeal, the sum of sixty two pounds eleven shillings and four pence three farthings from off the Lands of Skidowe, and the sum of Thirty six pounds four shillings and five pence one farthing from off the Lands of Killeegh; making together the first mentioned sum of One hundred and sixty eight pounds three shillings and five pence halfpenny Sterling. And I do further certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November One thousand eight hundred and thirty is Thirty two shillings and one halfpenny per Barrell -
