made the nineteenth Day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven Between The Reverend James Verschoy le of Saint Patrick Dublin and the Chapter of the same of the one part and Forster Hill Forster of Forrest in the said Dean and Chapter being capitularily congregated in the Chapter house of the said Cathedral Church consideration of the surrender of a former Lease heretofore made of the herein after mentioned premises as and Agreements herein after contained HAVE demised granted set and to farm let and by these presents & Forster his Executors Administrators and Assigns **All that and Those** the Tythes of the great Reinondston Rathangell and the Altarages, (excepting the oblations payable to the Vicar of Swords) the Parish of Swords and County of Dublin **To have and To hold** the said Tythes and all other saving to the Vicar of Swords as aforesaid unto the said Forster Hill Forster his Executors Administrators and for and during the term time and space of twenty one years then and from thenceforth next unto the said Dean and Chapter and their Successors or to their Proctor for the time being half yearly that is to say on every Twenty ninth Day of September and twenty fifth inuance of this Demise by even and equal portions the first payment thereof to be made on two fat Capons at every Christmas or five shillings in lieu thereof at the election of the said twelve pence in the pound unto the Proctor of the said Cathedral Church for the time being for the same the said Yearly Rent, duties, and proctors fees to be paid as aforesaid without any subsidies charges or impositions whatsoever ordinary or extraordinary **20/-** if it shall es or any part thereof be behind or unpaid by the space of Twenty one Days next after &
