We Thomas Lancaster of Tortwilliam Esq^r and William Rigney of Tochnacconell Gentleman both of the County of Roscommon Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of An Act made in the fourth Year of the Reign of King George the fourth Intituled an Act to provide for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in the land for a limited time And another Act made in the fifth Year of the Reign of King George the fourth Intituled an Act to amend an Act of the last Session of Parliament for providing for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing, yielded and payable, within the Parish of Tochnacconell in the Union of Meagh & County of Roscommon Do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish pursuant to an Agreement between the Tithe Owners, and the Parishioners and persons paying Tithes in said Parish is One Hundred and sixty pounds payable half yearly by equal parts on every first day of May and first day of October - pounds Ster^l by the year of which One hundred and seven and ten pence being three fourths parts (Except the Decimies) are due and payable to the Rev^d Patrick Pauden as a Composition for Tithe Claimable by him as Rector of said Parish Thirty nine pounds One fourth part (Exclusive of the Decimies as aforesaid) are due and payable to the Right Rev^d Christ. Lord Bishop of Clonfert as a Composition for the Tithe Claimable by him and four pounds are due and payable to the Very Rev^d Tho^s Hawkins as a Composition for Tithe Claimable by him as Dean of Clonfert And We do further Certify that the Average price of Oats being the Com^o principle grown in P^r County for the period of seven Years ending the first day of Nov^r One thousand eight hundred and twenty one is fifteen Shillings & ten pence per Quarter Given under our Hands this ninth day of Dec^r 1825 True
