We Thomas Lancaster of Fortwilliam Esq. and William Regney of Lockmacconnell Gentlemen both in the County of Roscommon Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth Intituled an Act to provide for Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for an limited term; And an other act made in the fifth year of the Reign of King George the fourth Intituled An Act amend an Act of the last Session of Parliament for providing for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland to ascertain and fix a true & just Composition for all Tithes arising growing & yielded and payable within the Parish of Lockmacconnell in the Union of Crough and County of Roscommon, Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish pursuant to an agreement Between the Tithes Owners and the Parishioners & persons paying Tithes in said Parish is One hundred and sixty pounds Sterling by the Year payable half yearly by equal gales on every first day of May & first day of Nov. Of which One hundred and twenty or pounds being three fourth parts (except the Deanery) are due & payable to the Rev. Pat. Pender as a Composition for Tithes Claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish thirty nine pounds One fourth part (exclusive of the Deanery as aforesaid) are due and payable to the Right Rev. the Lord Bishop of Clonfert & as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him and four pounds are due and payable to the Very Rev. Thomas Hawkins as a Composition for Tithes Claimable by him as Dean of Clonfert, And we do further Certify that the average price of Oats being the Corn principally growing in said County for the period of seven years ending the first day of November one thousand Eight hundred and twenty one is fifteen Shillings & two pence farthing per Barrel - Given under our Hands this ninth day of Decr 1825 five
