yielding or payable within the parish  
of Taspree in the County of Mayo  
do hereby certify - that the true &  
just amount of composition for  
all tithes whatever within the said  
parish of Taspree is one hundred  
and twelve pounds - Fifteen shillings -  
and eleven pence - three farthings  $\text{£}112 = 15 = 11\frac{3}{4}$

By the year - and the whole is due  
& payable to the Rev: John Joyce  
as a composition for all tithes  
claimable by him as the rector  
& vicar of said parish of Taspree  
and we do further certify
