I John Grey of Claresmorris in the
County of Mayo being seized in fee simple
of All that and those the Townland of
Coursfield Situate in the Parish of Tullybrannigan
in the Union of Wexford County of Wexford
and County of Mayo (as otherwise intitled)
according to the provisions of ^{the} said Act I agree for
and undertake the payment of the composition for
Tithes lawfully payable for and in respect of the said
lands do hereby signify my desire to agree for
and undertake the payment of such composition
as aforesaid for and in respect of the said lands
and I hereby require you to grant me a Certificate
in Writing conformable to the provisions of the
said Act declaring me entitled to the benefit
of this Notice and to perform the other matters
on your part required by the said Act
to be done Dated this 26th day of
October 1834 your
