I Henry Gustavus Nicholls, Appointed Commissioner by His Excellency The Lord Lieutenant, for the Parish of Loughshinod, in the Diocese of Ardagh, and County of Longford, do hereby Certify that I have viewed all Parts of said Parish, and caused to be brought before me all existing Surveys and Maps, which I conceived to be necessary to enable me to make a fair Composition for the Payment of Tithes in said Parish, and where none existed or could be found, caused Survey to be made, and (Exclusive of all Waste by Law exempted) I find that the said Parish contains 3136.1.27¹/₂ Irish Plantation Measure, which is equal to 5628.1.28¹/₂ British Statute Measure, that are subject to the Payment of Composition for Tithes. — Road or Waste 22.1.33¹/₂ Irish Plantation Measure and Glebe lands 30.0.0 Irish Plantation Measure and of a Bog (Pasturable or Incapable) Tithable as before in its plotment, 338.0.19¹/₂ Irish Plantation Measure, making in all the said Parish 3527.0.0 Irish, Equal to 5713.0.25¹/₂ British Statute Acres. —

And the Sum assessed on all the Parish (not Tithable) is 100 Hundred and Thirty Pounds and Three Pence and One Farthing Sterling, by the Year. — being the Average of the seven years preceding the first day of November 1830. Of which Sum the Reverend W. C. Armstrong as Rector of said Parish is entitled to One Hundred and Fifty Six Pounds, five Shillings and Ten Pence half penny Sterling. — And the said Rev. W. C. Armstrong as Vicar of the Abbeylands of Abbeydarrig or Abbeydarick in said Parish is entitled to the sum of Thirteen Pounds Eleven Shillings and Nine Pence half penny Sterling, — And the Countess Dowager of Rosse, is entitled to the Remainder of said Tithes of the said Abbeylands, as Lay-Impropriator. — And that the said Rev. W. C. Armstrong as Vicar of the Townlands of Loughan and Torboy, in said Parish is entitled to Twelve Pounds Eighteen Shillings and Nine Pence Sterling, And Messrs Pausenby and Callion, are supposed to be entitled to the Remainder of said Tithes of

said Townlands of Loughan and Torboy, as Lay Impropriators, but for some Immemorial, have not demanded or received any Tithes in said Townlands. — And that the Rev. Richard S. George of Tashingy Glebe as Vicar of the Townlands of Lisnacevagh and Balnamanagh in said Parish, is entitled to Fourteen Pounds Nineteen Shillings and Three farthings Sterling, out of the said Sands of Lisnacevagh and Balnamanagh. —

I have divided the several lands of said Parish generally into three Classes, and made a separate Valuation for each holding according to its present Value, and assessed each holding per acre, with its proportion of the said Composition according to its Value, and appraised the same accordingly, as is fully stated in the annexed Book.
