

To the Remainder of said Tithes of said Town-lands of  
Loughan and Torboy as Lay Impropriation. but for time  
Immemorial have not demanded, or received any Tithes  
in said Town-lands - And that the Rev. Rich<sup>d</sup>. St. George  
of Tashing-Glebe as Vicar of the Townlands of Lisnacreevagh  
and Balnamonagh in said Parish is entitled to  
Twenty Pounds Nineteen shillings and three farthings  
sterling Out of the said Town-lands of Lisnacreevagh  
and Balnamonagh. And I further Certify that  
the average price of Oats being the Corn generally  
grown in said Parish is Thirteen shillings and  
five pence ster. per Barrel.
