£215ⁿ 13ⁿ 8 - by the year - is due and payable
to the Honble Baron Foster as Improprator, and the
remaining sum of £44ⁿ 10ⁿ 0. due and payable to the
Rev^d Richard O'pharts as Vicar of said Parish.
