

I, Henry Marcus Crofton, Vicar and  
Ecclesiastical Incumbent of Taughbry parish,  
in the counties of Roscommon & Galway,  
and diocese of Elphin, do hereby nominate  
and appoint L<sup>td</sup> Colonel Rich<sup>d</sup> Kelly,  
of Mucklow, in the county of Galway,  
to be a Commissioner on the part of myself,  
as proprietor of the Vicarial tithes, and on  
the part of the R<sup>ts</sup> Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Incorporated  
Society, as proprietors of the Improprate tithes  
of said parish, to treat with George Kelly Esq,  
the Commissioner appointed by the owners and  
occupiers of land within said parish of Taughbry,  
for the purposes of the Act of Parliament of  
the fourth year of King George the fourth, Chap  
99, entitled, "An Act to provide for the establishing  
"of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a  
"determined time—"
