

We Whittor Wilson & Richard Ryan Commissioners duly
appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in
the Tenth Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, intituled
"An Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes
"in Ireland for a limited time" do ascertain and fix a true
and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded
or payable within the Parish of Coddor in the County of
Meath, do hereby certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish
is forty pounds, by the Year, the whole of which is due
and payable to the Misses Blundells as a Composition for the
Tithes claimable by them as Improvers of the said Parish.

And we do further certify that the Average price of
Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for
the period of seven years ending on the 1st day of November 1825
is two pound eighteen shillings & eight pence farthing
late Irish Currency per Barrel.
