as a Composition for the Tithe claimable by him  
as Rector and Vicar of the said Parish

And We do further Certify, that the average  
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in  
such County for the period of Seven Years ending on the  
First day of November 1830 is 13.. 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> p<sup>r</sup> Barrell
