in the fourth, fifth, seventh and eighth years
of the Reign of his late Majesty King George
the fourth, providing for the establishing
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland; and
to make such Compositions) According to the
directions of the said Act, and according to
equity and good Conscience, and without favour
or affection, Prejudice or Malice to any person
or persons whatsoever. So helps me God
Sworn before me this 29th
day of October 1832
