Under and by Virtue of an Act made in the second and third years
of the Reign of His present Majesty King William the Fourth
Entituled an Act to amend Three Acts passed respectively in the
Fourth, Fifth, and in the seventh and Eighth Years of the Reign of
His Late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the
establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make
such Compositions permanent, To ascertain and fix a True and
Just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielding or
payable within the Parish of Templebreedy in the Diocese of
Cork and County of Cork, Do hereby Certify that
the True and Just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within the said Parish is Two Hundred Pounds & twelve shillings by the
Year of which sum Two hundred Pounds the sum of One
Hundred and Sixty Pounds seven shillings and two pence
is due and payable to His Majesty the Dean of Cork as
a Composition for the Tithes claimed by him as Rector of said Parish
and the remaining sum of Thirty Nine pounds twelve shillings
and ten pence, is due and payable to The Rev^d William Coster
Williamson as perpetual Curate of said Parish being the amount
of all Tithes payable out of the Town Lands of Hodderfields
in said Parish as allocated for the payment of the perpetual Curate
of said Parish by Deed of Endowment bearing date the sixteenth
day of June One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirteen and
duly Enrolled in His Majesty's High Court of Chancery Under
and by Virtue of an Act passed in the Kingdom of Ireland in the
Eleventh and Twelfth Years of the Reign of His Late Majesty
King George the Third Entituled an Act for Erecting Parochial
Chapels of Ease &c and Chapter sixteenth, And I do further
Certify that the Average price of Wheat being the Corn princi-
-pally grown in such County for the period of seven Years ending
the first day of November One Thousand Eight hundred and
Thirty is One Pound Twelve shillings One Half penny per Barrel
