

The *Nassau Foster* and *John Miller* Commissioners duly appointed
and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth year
of the Reign of King George the Fourth, entitled an Act to Provide
for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a
limited time to Ascertain and fix a true and just composition
for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish
of Templemore and County of Downgal, do hereby Certify that the
true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within
said Parish is Two Hundred and Thirty five Pounds Sterling,
are due and payable to the Reverend Alexander Montgomery
as a Composition for all the Tithes claimable by him as Rector
of said Parish of Templemore for the term of Twentyone Years
from the first day of November next, without any change or
Variation (as by an agreement made to compound for the Tithes
of said Parish at a Special Vestry held under the Tithes Composition
Act the 28th day of April 1828) And we further Certify that
the Average price of Oats being the Corn principally grown
in said County of Downgal for the Period of Seven Years ending
the 1st day of November 1821 is fifteen Shillings and two pence
farthing by the Paris late Irish Currency, as by the Averages
extracted from the Dublin Gazette for Seven Years ending the 1st
of November 1821 given under our Hands this 20th day
May 1822
