and Make such Composition permanent to Ascertain and fix
a true and just Composition for all Tithes Arising Growing
yielded or payable within the Parish of Templeberry in the
County of Tipperary. do hereby Certify that the true and just
Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said
Parish is One hundred and fifty seven pounds nine Shillings and
three pence sterling by the year which Sum of One hundred and
fifty seven pounds, nine Shillings and three pence is due and payable
to the Rev. William Jordens Rector of the said Parish as a Compo-
sition for the Tithes Claimable by him

and I do further Certify that the average price of Wheat and
Oats being the Corn principally growing in said County for the period
of seven years ending the first day of November 1830

Wheat, one bush Twelve Shillings and one half penny and
Oats at Twelve Shillings Eleven pence half penny per Barrel
