

We Ralph Stony and Thomas Wille, Commissioners duly appointed and sworn, under an Act Made in the fourth Year of the Reign of King George the fourth, Entitled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, do Certify that the true & just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the Parish of Templedowny, as agreed upon at a Special Vestry held for that purpose is Ninety pounds Annually which Sum is due and sayable to the Hon^{ble} and Rev^d Father Vicar as a Composition for the Tithes Claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of said Parish. And we do further Certify that the Average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven Years, previous to and ending on the first of November 1824. is £1/8/8 in the Bushel
