 parish of Templebury a list of the owners
 and occupiers of land in said parish and
 also signify their consent that such composition
 shall be invariable for the term of 21 years
 from the first day of next next and that such
 composition shall continue to be binding for said
 term of 21 years and shall not be subject
 to any variation in the amount thereof
 during such period of 21 years under the
 provisions of the 4th of Geo IV (Chap 33) and 5th of Geo
 IV (Chap 33) whatever the price of corn may be
