

We Richard Ryan and Charles Barry  
Commissioners duly appointed and sworn  
under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth  
year of the Reign of King George the Fourth,  
intituled "An Act to provide for the establishing  
of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited  
time" to ascertain and fix a true and just  
composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded  
or payable within the Parish of Templeharan in the  
County of Meath, do hereby certify, that the true  
and just amount of composition for all tithes, what-  
-ever, within the said Parish, is one hundred and thirty  
pounds by the year. - Of which sum of one hundred  
and thirty pounds, the whole is due and payable, to  
the Reverend Stephen Rudcliffe, as a composition for  
the Tithe claimable by him, as Rector of the said  
Parish. And we do further certify, that the average  
price of Wheat, being the corn principally grown  
in such County, for the period of seven years, ending  
the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 1821, is one pound eighteen  
shillings, and eight pence halfpenny per Barrel.
