Hillend in the County of Wexford Commissioners duly
appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an
Act made in the 4th of George 4th the intitled Act
to provide for the settling of compositions
for tithes in Ireland for a limited term to ascer-
tain and fix a true and just composition for all
tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within
the Parish of St Peter's Templedye and do here by certify
that the true and just amount of the composition
for the vicarual tithes within the said Parish is
Two hundred and twenty one Pounds four Shillings and
one penny 1/4 by the year and which sum is
due and payable to the Rev^d Allen Morgan as
Incumbent or his Successors of said Parish each
and every year for Twenty one years from the first day
of Nov^r 1824.

And we do further certify that the average price
of oats being the principal grain in said Parish for
the period of seven years ending the year of 1821
is 15/6 per Bar^l.
