Whereas, *Francis Bruin Esq:*

has served me with a notice in writing, in the words and figures following:

SIR,

You are hereby required to take notice, that in pursuance of an act passed in the second and third year of his present Majesty, entitled "An act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty, King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such compositions permanent," I, *Francis Bruin Esq:*

of *Coolbawn* in the county of *Wexford* being seized in Fee Simple & Landlord

of all that and those, Townlands - that is to say - *Askeinferry* containing two hundred, sixty nine Acres, one Rood, thirty three Perches. *Ballybawn* two hundred, eighty four acres. *Ballygibbon* one hundred, thirty three acres, one Rood. *Coolbawn* two hundred, seventeen acres, three Roods, twenty Perches. *Mulgarron* one hundred, sixty three acres, two Roods, thirteen Perches. *Mullinamogh* two hundred, sixty seven acres, one Rood. *Tomanine* two hundred, forty three acres, one Rood, two perches and *Monasmullin*, four hundred, sixty six acres, being in all eight Townlands and containing altogether Two thousand, forty four acres, two Roods, & twenty eight Perches, Irish measure; & which Townlands are bounded on the North by the river Boro, separating them from the Parish of Killan, on the East by the Parish of Killary, on the South by the Townlands of *Rathfardm*, *Ballinderry* & *Templeendigan*, all in the said Parish of *Templeendigan* & on the West by the *Black Stairs* mountain which separates the Counties, *Wexford* & *Carlow*.
