and fix a true and just composition
for all tithes arising growing yielded
or payable within the Parish of Sanfield
- Miltown in the County of Cork, Do hereby
Certify that the true and just composition
- due for all tithes whatsoever within the
said Parish is Five Hundred and nineteen
pounds sterling by the year - of which
sum of Five Hundred and nineteen
pounds the sum of Five Hundred pounds
is due and payable to the very Rev
Robert Burdocks, Dean of Cork, as a
composition for the tithes claimable by
him as Rector of said Parish, and the
sum of Nineteen pounds is due and
payable to the Rev. Francis C. Sullivan
as a composition for the tithes claimable
by him as perpetual Curate of said
Parish
