tithes claimable by him as Rector of
said Parish and the sum of nineteen
pounds is due and payable to the
Rev^d Francis C. Sullivan as a composi-
-tion for the tithes claimable by him
as perpetual Curate of said Parish.

And I do further certify that the
average price of wheat being the
Corn

Corn principally grown in such County
for the period of seven years ending
on the 1st day of November 1830 thirty
is One pound twelve shillings and one
halfpenny Sterg. per barrel, as published
in the Dublin Gazette.
