

I Francis Depard (duely appointed and sworn under  
and by virtue of an Act, made in the second and third  
years of the Reign of King William the fourth entitled  
an Act to amend three Acts past respectively in  
the fourth, fifth, seventh and eight years of the Reign  
of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing  
for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland,  
and to make such Compositions permanent, and to  
ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all  
Tithes arising, growing, yielding, or payable within the  
Parish of Templemichael in the County of Tipperary,  
do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composi-  
tion for all Tithes payable within the said Parish is  
One hundred and eighty <sup>389</sup> pounds, <sup>12</sup> s. by the year, which  
sum of One hundred and eighty is due and payable to the  
Rev<sup>d</sup> Parish Priest as Rector, and Cosue Sutton Esq<sup>r</sup>. as  
Impropriator of said Parish - viz the sum of One hundred  
and twenty pounds, <sup>288</sup> s. to the Rector, and the sum of
