That in pursuance of an Act of

Parliament passed in the 2nd and 3rd years of his present Majesty
 entitled "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th
 " 5th and in the 7th and 8th years of the reign of his late Majesty King ^{George}
 " the 11th providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in
 " Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent" And of
 an Act passed in the 3rd and 4th years of the same reign of the ~~same~~
~~same~~ entitled, "An Act for the Relief of the Owners of Tithes in Ireland
 " And for the Amendment of an Act passed in the last Session of Parliament
 " entitled An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th 5th and
 " in the 7th and 8th years of the reign of his late Majesty, King George the 11th
 " Providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and

 in the Parish of Temple Michael and County of Longford - ~~And also~~
 the lands of Glack, Farnagh, Ferriafad, Bally McKegan and
 Lirauff, which said lands are situate in the Parish of Ballymacormack
 and County of Longford, All which said lands are Bounded
 on the North by Glonball on the East by Gloncourse, Ballymacmillium
 Cartrons and Lirauff, on the South by Frocholman and the
 Great Bog, and on the West by Treelick, Garrowagh, Farnyhoogaw
 and also the lands of Garrowagh in the Parish of Temple Michael

 under your hand and seal, reciting this Notice and declaring me entitled
