Notice in writing has been served upon me as Ecclesiastical Incumbent of the Parishes of Temple Michael and Ballymacormack in the County of Longford aforesaid, by or on behalf of the Right Honble Thomas Earl of Longford which said Notice is as follows: that is to say, **Take Notice, That** in pursuance of an Act of Parliament passed in the 2nd and 3rd years of his present Majesty entitled "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th and in the 7th and 8th years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the 4th providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent;" and of an Act passed in the 3rd and 4th years of the same reign entitled, "An Act for the relief of the owners of Tithes in Ireland, and for the amendment of an Act passed in the last Session of Parliament entitled "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th and in the 7th and 8th years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the 4th providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent"- I do hereby signify my desire and intention to agree for and undertake the future payment of the Composition and of all sums which shall become due and payable on account of the Composition

which under the laws in force in Ireland for the Composition of Tithes is now fixed and established as the Composition for all Tithes for and in respect of the lands of Aughadeignan, Abbey Carton, Deanes Curragh, Knockahough, Ardmacassagh, Lismuck, Curraghacaw, Coolnalinch, White Rock, Lower Coolney, ^{Lisbrack Townparks of Longford and Dunesy lands of Longford,} Upper Coolney, ^{Kilnashaboye, Curraghacaw and Lisbrack,} all which said lands are situate in the parishes of Temple Michael and County of Longford **and also** the lands of Glack, Farnagh Terrafad, Ballymacormack and Lisduff which said lands are situate in the Parish of Ballymacormack and County of Longford All which said lands are bounded on the North by Clombatt on the East by Gloncause, Ballymacormack William, Cartons and Lisdownan, on the South by Freeholman and the Great Bog and on the West by Freeliak, Corrowagh, Farneshogon, ^{and also the lands of Curraghacaw in the said parish of Temple Michael} Ballymacormack and Cartons, **And** Thereby require you in pursuance of the provisions of the said Acts to grant me a Certificate under your hand and seal reciting this Notice ^{do} and declaring me entitled to the benefit thereof" **And** Thereby certify and declare that the said Earl of Longford is entitled to the benefit thereof as to the said lands a Map, Trench or ground plan whereof is hereunto annexed
