 Incumbent of the Parish of Sempulmichal in the County of Longford said Gentling
 Whereas George Hyson Esq Agent to Lord and Lady Edgeworth Esqrs in the
 County of Longford has duly served me with a Notice in Writing in the Words
 And Figures following. *W^h* you are hereby required to take notice that in
 pursuance of an Act passed in the 2^d and 3^d years of the Reign of his Majesty
 King William the fourth Entitled an Act to Amend three Acts passed
 respectively in the 4th and 5th and in the 7th and 8th years of the Reign of his
 Late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the Establishing of Compositions
 for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent I George Hyson
 Esq Agent to Lord and Lady Edgeworth Esqrs Chief Landlord served in fee
 Simple of all that and those the lands of Cashion viz Blomahussy Williamston
 Poulfin Lisuadoolans and Supparethard all Situated and being
 in the Parish of Sempulmichal and Barony of Adolph and County of
 Longford a Writing therein Entitled according to the Provisions of said Act
 to Agree for and undertake the payment of said Composition for Tithes
 Lawfully payable for and in respect of said lands do hereby signify to
 you my desire to Agree for and undertake the payment of such Com-
 position as Appraisers for and in respect of the said lands and I
 hereby require you to Grant me a Certificate in Writing conformable to
 the provisions of said Act declaring me Intitled to the Benefit of this
 Notice and to perform the other Matters on your part required by the
 said Act to be done
