application having been first affixed
at the times and in the manner directed
by the Statute in that Case made and
provided by the Reverend James Bagge
Vicar of the Parish of Templemichael
in said Division of said County in
the Diocese of Lismore Division of
Lismore and County of Waterford
and being a party entitled to the receipt
of a proportion of the Rentcharge payable
in lieu of the Composition for Tithes
within the said Parish made by the
Certificate of Samuel Smith Esquire
bearing date the sixteenth day of
October one thousand eight hundred
and thirty three and in pursuance of
the Statutes in that Case made and
provided and whereby the gross
amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatever in the said Parish was certified
to be six hundred and sixty pounds
fourteen shillings and sixpence, the
said James Bagge made application in
writing to the Justices of the Peace at the
Quarter
