establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ire-
land for a limited time) to ascertain and
fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes
arising, growing, yielded or payable within
the Parish of Temple Michael de duagh in
the County of Cork, do hereby Certify that
the true and just amount of Composition
for all Tithes whatsoever within the said
Parish is Two hundred and sixty six Pounds
Sterling by the year.

And we do further certify that the Average
price of wheat, (being the Corn principally
grown in such County,) for the period of
Seven years ending the first day of
November 1821 is thirty eight shillings and
eight pence half penny
