Revd John O'Rourke as Vicar of the said Parish,
and I do further certify that the average price of Oats, being the Corn principally grown
in said County for the period of Seven Years, ending on the First day of November, One
Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty, is *Twelve Shillings and Eleven*
pence one half penny Sterling per Barrel.
