And we do hereby Order
and direct that the said annual
Composition for the Hay or Improprate
Tithes in said Parish of Templemore
be varied in proportion to the said
average price of wheat And
we hereby ascertain and fix
the annual Composition for
the Hay or Improprate Tithes
in the said parish of Templemore
for the 4 years commencing 1st day
of Nov^r 1891 at the sum of £218
.. 16 .. 2 1/2 in lieu of the said annual
Composition of £420 .. 0 .. 0 as
aforesaid found by the said
Certificate and until the same.

shall be again varied pursuant
to the provisions of the said several
statutes or any Act or Acts so
amending the same.

And we do hereby further
find and ascertain that the
Tithes Rent Charge payable
in lieu of the said Composition
in said parish amounts to the
sum of £164 .. 2 .. 2 And we
Order that the apportionment be
amended accordingly.

And we Order and
direct that all said parties do bear
their own costs of said application
